



PAPER PLATE ANGEL

PREP TIME

15-20 minutes

MAKES 1

YOU WILL NEED

White paper plate (any size)
Glitter glue (any colour)
Pipe cleaner
White paper
Colouring pencils
Scissors

A fun, easy craft activity using things you can find around the house. The angels can be decorated and personalised for that added element of creativity!

To make it extra special

Spray paint over a paper doily onto the plate, then remove the doily to reveal a lacy pattern for the angel's wings.

1. Carefully cut a small triangle out of a white paper plate that reaches to the middle of the plate. Put this aside for now.
2. Draw lines from the middle of the plate to the edges using glitter glue, forming the wings. Leave this to dry.
3. From the piece of paper, cut out a circle and decorate for the angel's face and two small ovals for their hands.
4. Stick these onto the triangle cut out in step 1, with the face at the pointy end and hands on the sides, forming the angel's body.
5. Once the plate is dry, tape the angel's body to plate wings.
6. Cut a pipe cleaner in half and bend into a halo. Flip plate over and tape onto body from the back.
